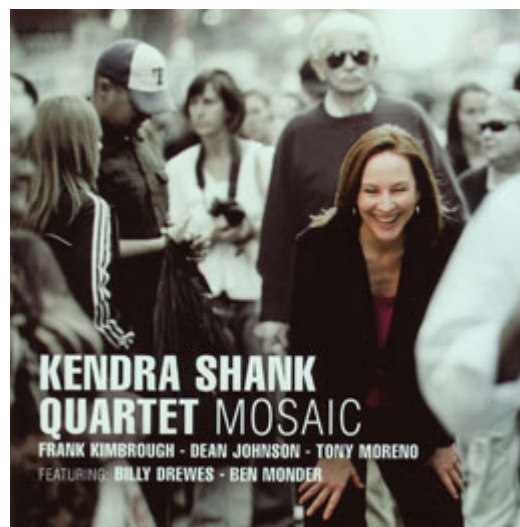
New & Recommended Jazz CDs by Bob Bernotas, Host of WNTI's Just Jazz

Kendra Shank: Mosaic

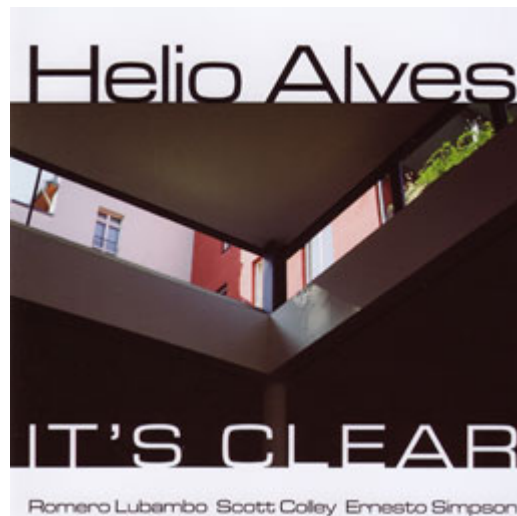
(Challenge): Kendra Shank does things that few other singers would attempt - or imagine. She and longtime colleagues pianist Frank Kimbrough, bassist Dean Johnson, and drummer Tony Moreno have transcended the familiar "singer plus rhythm" format to create a truly collaborative unit. Every track of this striking new release, some augmented by saxophonist Billy Drewes and guitarist Ben Monder, illustrates their cohesive interplay.

Helio Alves: It's Clear

(Reservoir Music): This latest release by Brazilian pianist Helio Alves proves, without question, that he belongs among the top rank of today's keyboard artists. Alves and a Pan-American ensemble - Brazilian guitarist Romero Lubambo, American bassist Scott Colley, Cuban drummer Ernesto Simpson - turn out some superior Brazilian-infused jazz, mixing original tunes with pieces by Moacir Santos, Egberto Gismonti, Tom Jobim, and others.



Bobby Sanabria & the Manhattan School of Music Afro-Cuban Jazz Orchestra: Kenya Revisited Live!!!

(Jazzheads): Conducting, and performing with, this superb conservatory orchestra, percussionist Bobby Sanabria offers a reverent and impeccably rendered tribute to one of the landmark recordings of Afro-Cuban jazz, Machito's 1957 classic, Kenya. The astounding 87-year-old conga master, Candido, who played on the original Machito sessions, adds his unique energy to several tracks.
